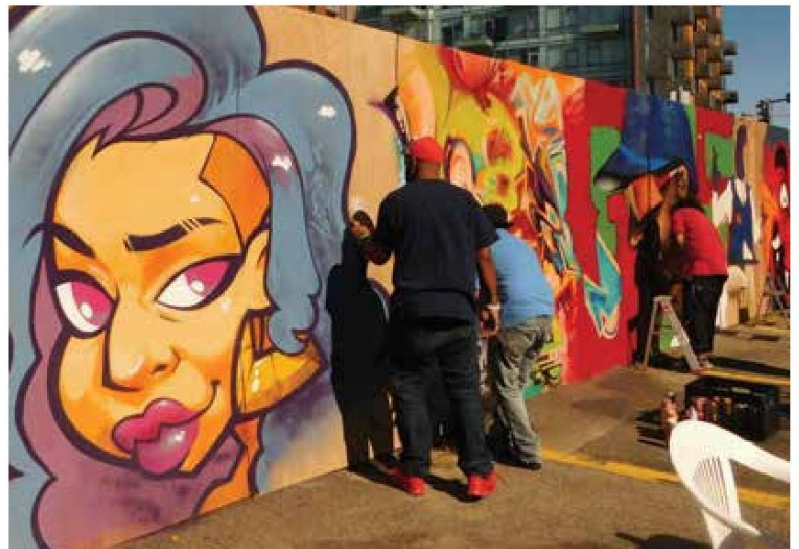

### DA to investigate killing of South End man

Police, family accounts differ

On Sunday, October 30 at 12:39 two police officers and two Boston EMS workers responded to a call to 245 Shawmut Ave. for a "emotionally disturbed male in his 30s suffering from paranoia and schizophrenia."

Boston Police Commissioner William Evans said the EMT workers were helping the man from the apartment when he drew a knife and attacked them. The officers intervened and he attacked them. Each officer fired once and the suspect was hit twice. The man was taken to the hospital and died from his wounds. The man's name, according to a report in The Boston Globe, was Terrence Coleman.

Suffolk District Attorney Daniel F. Conley's office is conducting independent investigation.

IBA's supported-living house gets a makeover

IBA's Residencia Betances, one of only a few housing facilities in Boston offering supportive services to formerly homeless, Spanish speaking residents, received a makeover recently, and Inquilinos Boricuas en Acción (IBA) CEO Vanessa Calderón-Rosado celebrated the completed renovation on Thursday,

October 27 with city and state housing and social service officials. Opened in 1993, Residencia Betances provides 11 single-occupancy units for formerly homeless residents who are clients of the Department of Mental Health, with round-the-clock, bilingual staff on site to assist residents with medication and health-care appointments, social skills symptom management and meal preparation, and to provide social, employment skills and wellness opportunities. "Residencia Betances is such a meaningful part of Boston's South End, and we are proud to have completed renovations that will enhance the lives of our residents," said Vanessa Calderón-Rosado. "We are grateful to those that have helped make this project happen, and look forward to continuing with more work aimed at providing affordable housing for those in need." The renovation, which received funding from the Department of Housing and Community Development's (DHCD) Housing Preservation Stabilization and Facilities Consolidation program and from the Community Economic Development Assistance Corporation (CEDAC), will provide a more open and client-friendly common area; historic restoration of the brick townhouse's exterior and upgrades in the residents' units.

### Mayor Walsh Supports Library Renovation

Mayor Marty Walsh, in a meeting held at the South End library on December 8, responded positively to efforts by the library's Friends' group to renovate and redesign the branch library and its adjacent Library Park, which is used extensively for children's programming and the popular summer Jazz & Blues concerts by Pat Loomis and his Friends. The meeting, the third annual "conversation with the Mayor" on a number of topics sponsored by the South End Forum, brought Mayor Walsh in direct visual contact with the cramped condition of the branch, where as little as 4,000 square feet is divided between children and adults, many of them homeless, a number of them suffering from mental health and addiction problems.

"I saw it," the Mayor said when the Friends of the South End Library (FOSEL) pointed out the difficulty for the staff to manage the

adult population seated in close proximity to the children's room. The South End's teenage patrons, moreover, have no space available to them at all at this branch.


